While there, Mike participated in a broad range of investment opportunities across the U.S., Canada, Indonesia, Malaysia, Vietnam, Australia and Germany.

Prior to that, he served in the U.S. Army. His final assignment was as the Chief of Defense Cooperation at the U.S. Embassy in Jakarta, Indonesia. While there, he oversaw a sizable Foreign Military Sales program including fighter aircraft, attack helicopters, boats and weapons. Assignments previous to that included Army Attaché at the U.S. Embassy in Beijing, congressional staffer with the U.S.-China Economic and Security Review Commission, think-tank fellow with the Center for Strategic and International Studies, and Assistant Country Director in the Office of the Secretary of Defense. As an artillery officer, he completed a combat tour in Iraq, commanded an MLRS rocket battery in Germany, served on a nuclear weapons site in Turkey and as a forward observer on the DMZ in Korea.
